Workshop Program

Frost has a diverse range of creative workshops on offer. Learn some new skills or brush up on some old ones by enrolling in one or more of our workshops.

Friday 6 July

Introduction to Mosaic Making

10am-4pm

Local artist Arlene Weekes will take you through the basics of mosaic making in her studio and show you how to grout your work. Materials provided. Limit of 6. \$90.

Photography

10am to 3pm

Glen Innes photographer Steve Wright will show you what can be done with Photoshop. Bring some images of your own. Limit of 12. \$90.

Saturday 7 July

YUPO Painting

10am to 3pm

Well-known Manilla painter Erik Dekkers will share some of the secrets of producing tantalising works on YUPO paper. YUPO is a synthetic paper that can be used to make images with interesting visual effects with paint. Suitable for beginners to advanced painters. Limit of 12. \$100.

Jewellery

10am to 1pm

Make finished pieces of jewellery to take home, using semi-precious stones, glass lampwork beads, sterling silver components and Swarovski crystals. Barraba jewellery maker Elizabeth Cox will teach you the process. Kit provided in fee. Choices available to suit different tastes. Make a necklace, or an earring & bracelet set. Limit of 10. Children OK if accompanied by an adult. \$60.

Painting, drawing or photography at historic Barraba Station

9.30am to 1.30pm

Two tutors will help you have a unique artistic experience at Barraba Station, a property first taken up by white settlers in 1838. The property is a short drive from town. Explore and paint, draw or photograph this historic homestead, grounds, and shearing shed. Morning tea provided. All skill levels. Limit of 10 per tutor. \$90.

Sunday 8 July

Landscape painting in acrylic/oils

10am to 3pm

Experiment some techniques for painting landscape with Tamworth artist Jodie Herden. Bring your own materials. You will need at least basic painting experience. Limit 12. \$100

Watercolour painting

10am to 3pm

Renowned watercolourist Yvonne Overton is conducting this workshop designed to give beginners some basic techniques in handling the watercolour medium or the more experienced artist to refresh their methods. The morning will be discussion and practical exercises; the afternoon will be start/complete a small landscape. Paper supplied. Limit of 12. \$110.
